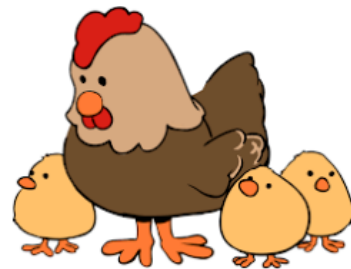
Los pollitos dicen pío, pío, pío
